EU ERASMUS+ PROGRAM

Since 2013, KLU has been participating in the ERASMUS+ program, the European Union flagship training and education program. Our Erasmus code is D Hamburg19. For further information, please contact the International Office.

REQUIREMENTS

English language skills:

TOEFL (95 iBT), IELTS (6.5), EU-CEFR form (Level C1) or equivalent (not older than two years). If the study program is held entirely in English, an official letter from the school is sufficient. These rules apply for all students, native speaker or not.

Academic skills:

good academic skills. The workload at KLU is high and professors expect active participation.

DEADLINES

Nomination (by the International Office of home university):

Fall semester: April 30
Spring semester: September 30

Registration (also for free-movers):

Fall semester: May 31
Spring semester: October 31

TUITION FEES AND FREE MOVERS

Tuition fees are waived for students with a signed reciprocal KLU student exchange agreement who have been formally nominated by their home university. All other students, i.e. free movers, are required to pay the tuition fees per KLU semester.

COURSES



Incoming exchange students can choose among KLU's excellent courses, and will be part of the KLU student body during their semester abroad. In addition to the lectures, the exchange students can participate in the wide-ranging extracurricular program.

STUDY PROGRAMS

KLU offers the following programs for exchange students:

BSc Business Administration
MSc International Management
MSc Global Logistics & Supply Chain Management
MSc Business Analytics & Data Science

All program are offered entirely in English.

MANDATORY COURSE REGISTRATION

Soon after having been nominated by your home university electronically, you will receive an online link to complete your registration as exchange student.

Students are allowed to take at maximum courses equivalent to 30 ECTS per semester.

There are no mandatory courses for exchange students.

As a general rule, you should consider one ECTS to be equivalent to 30 hours of course work. Please consult with your home university to determine which courses can be credited to your studies at home. You must make your final choice of courses within the registration period.



GRADING SCALE

The grading scale used at KLU ranges from 1.0 to 5.0. For example, 1.0 and 1.3 are outstanding results, 4.0 is the lowest passing grade.

SCHEDULES

The preliminary schedules are usually available on our intranet four weeks prior to the beginning of classes.

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

4-6 weeks after the exam period students should download transcripts from the internal portal "CAS campus".

SOP MOBILITY ONLINE

KLU's International Office uses the online tool „Mobility Online“ to administrate the incoming and outgoing exchange mobilities.

ACCOMMODATION


KLU Student Services offers support to find suitable accommodation for exchange students.
